

How to Access the Wall Street Journal Online through the Ramsey Free Public Library

How it Works

- Get free access to all of the Wall Street Journal (WSJ) Online's content.
- To access WSJ content, visit the library's website and click on our WSJ Access link – this will bring you to the WSJ website where you will receive a redeem code for 72-hour access to WSJ online.
- You can redeem as many 72-hour access codes as you want – simply redeem a new code after the first 24 hours has expired. You can continue to do this every 24 hours without any limits.
- Available for Ramsey Free Public Library cardholders ONLY. Members of other BCCLS (Bergen County Cooperative Library System) libraries do not have access.

Steps – Getting Access Using a Browser

1. Click on the Access Wall Street Journal button on the library's website, under Digital Collections.
2. If you don't have an account already, click on the redeem code link from the library's website and then fill out the form to register. You will only need to create a free account one time.
3. Login to your account using the device you want to read the WSJ. If you have your device/browser save your login information, you will only need to login one time.
4. Visit our library's website and click on the WSJ Access button.
5. You will be brought to a screen to redeem your free access code – click on REDEEM
6. You will now have free access to the WSJ for a 72-hour period. This means you can read/access as much content as you want within that period.
